- Membership Dues that considers the economic climate and needs of all.
- High Holiday Ticket Prices that are scaled based on membership, member relatives, guests and non-members
- School Tuition that is subsidized from membership dues, grants and donations.
- B'nai Mitzvah Training that continues in the tradition of TBI
- Building and Maintenance Fees (Included in membership or currently suspended)
- Other Fees and Donations for services rendered or use of facilities.

Membership Categories

FAMILY – A family membership will consist of a married couple, or an adult partnership, both who are under the age of 65 at the beginning of the fiscal year, and **do not have children in Religious School**. A family membership will be provided 4 High Holyday tickets at no charge.

SINGLE – A single membership will consist off a single person or a single parent, under the age of 65 at the beginning of the fiscal year - **with no children in Religious School** a single membership will be provided 1 High Holyday ticket at no additional cost.

SENIOR COUPLE – A senior couple membership will consist of a married couple or an adult partnership, with one person 65 years of age or higher at the beginning of the fiscal year. A senior couple membership will be provided 2 High Holyday tickets at no additional cost.

SENIOR SINGLE - A senior single membership will consist of a single person, 65 years of age or higher at the beginning of the fiscal year. A senior single membership will be provided 1 High Holyday ticket at no additional cost.

YOUNG ADULT - A single young adult membership will consist of any person age 18-29 at the beginning of the fiscal year. A young adult membership will be provided 1 High Holyday ticket at no additional cost.

SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP – A school membership will consist of a married couple, partnership or single parent with one or more children enrolled in the TBI School. - **Regular membership fees for this category will be waived during the year(s) that children are in attendance of TBI School**. A school membership will be provided 2 High Holyday tickets at no additional cost.

LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP – Offered to seniors who wish to make TBI their spiritual home on a permanent basis for the remainder of their life. Lifetime membership provides for a discounted fee over the course of 5 to 15 years depending on age with no increase in dues year to year. See appendix A for details of fees. Lifetime members are asked to provide a donation for High Holyday seating.

ETERNAL MEMBERSHIP – For existing members who have passed on and wish to be memorialized for eternity. A brass memorial plaque will be mounted in the sanctuary with the name of the departed and year of birth with no end date of life. See appendix A for detail of fees.

Notes:

- Congregants are requested to have dues and/or tuition paid in full by March 1st, 2020.
- After March 1st, 2020, a surcharge of 2 % per month may be applied to the remaining monthly balance for any past due membership dues unless prior arrangements have been made with the treasurer for delayed payment by January 31, 2020.
- Surcharges will apply to value of membership dues only; they will not apply to the value of Renovation, Maintenance, School tuition or fees or other statement charges.
- All payments will be posted to any prior year(s) outstanding balance before being applied to the current fiscal year dues or fees.
- Membership accounts that are past due as of March 1st, 2020 may result in a loss of voting at annual meeting and/or other privileges.

Maintenance Fees

For 2019/2020, the Annual Maintenance Fee is included in the Membership Fee. This may change in future years.

Building Fund Fees

For 2019/2020, the Annual Building Fund Fee has been waived for current and new members. This may change in future years.

School Tuition

Registration:

Registration should be made with the education director no later July 1st of the fiscal year. A minimum deposit of \$250 is required at time of registration. Registration for returning students after that date may be subject to a \$25.00 late registration fee which will be added to regular tuition fees. Tuition fees may be made on a monthly or quarterly basis and are to be paid in full prior to March 1, 2020. Registration may not be accepted if there is an outstanding membership or tuition balance from a previous year(s)

Schoolbooks will be available for purchase directly from the TBI School PTO committee in September.

B'nai Mitzvah Tutoring

B'nai Mitzvah Tutoring is to be scheduled through the school director using TBI Form B-2012-1 and approved by both the school director and Rabbi no later than 6 months prior to the schedule date. Upon form submittal B'nai Mitzvah Training fees will be added to the applicant's membership statement. **Tutoring fees must be paid in full 4 weeks prior to the scheduled B'nai Mitzvah date.**

Oneg Shabbat Donations

Membership Oneg

Members are encouraged to sponsor one Oneg per year on a date to be selected by the member.

Sponsored Oneg Shabbat – Normal Services (Standard cakes/cookies and refreshments only)

- Up to 25 People - \$40.00 plus a free will donation
- 26 - 50 People - \$75.00 plus a free will donation
- 50-75 People - \$100 plus a free will donation

B'nai Mitzvah/Baby Naming Oneg or Kiddush

- Cost of Food/Supplies as directed by the family/sponsor plus \$100.00 donation (includes both Friday and Saturday Oneg)

Dues/Tuition Payment Policies

- Membership Dues for the new fiscal year will be added to the May statement of the current fiscal year. Tuition will be added based on prior year enrollment.
- Membership Dues and Tuition may be made on a monthly or quarterly basis with final payments received by March 1, 2020 unless prior arrangements have been made with the Finance Committee. Memberships that do not meet this condition may be looked upon as a member not in good standing and may be subject to a surcharge.
- In order to obtain a Bar/Bat Mitzvah date, approval is required from the Rabbi and the School Director. Dues and Tuition must be current to obtain a Bar/Bat Mitzvah date. Any past due Dues and Tuition must be paid in full.
- All Fees for B'nai Mitzvah tutoring must be paid in full prior to your Bar/Bat Mitzvah date.
Adults receiving Bar/Bat Mitzvah training and planning on a ceremony must be members of Congregation Tiferes B'nai Israel...

Appendix A

LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP – Offered to seniors, age 65 through 85, who wish to make TBI their spiritual home on a permanent basis for the remainder of their life. Lifetime membership provides for a discounted fee which could be significant depending on entry age as it does not impound a dues increase year to year. In the case of a senior couple the lower age will be used to establish the lifetime membership fee. Lifetime membership will retain the same privilege levels as with a normal membership. Lifetime members will be honored with a brass nameplate mounted in the main hallway of TBI.

ETERNAL MEMBERSHIP –Eternal membership is offered to **Current or former** members who wish to be memorialized for eternity after passing on. Those wishing an eternal membership shall provide a donation that meets their personal financial position but is also appropriate to the honor bestowed to the individual. This may be made either prior to passing or as future donation as noted by a will, trust or family request. A brass memorial plaque will be mounted in the sanctuary with the name of the departed, the year of birth and membership date if provided, with no end date of life noted.
